



**DECLARATION FORM (to be signed by all participants in sponsored Accelerated Free Fall Level 1)**  
**Please read all sections of this page carefully before signing the declaration.**

**Booking terms and conditions**

1. You must raise a **minimum sponsorship £560** for your charity or group as detailed in your information pack.
2. Deposit for training must be submitted with Reservation Form, and remainder paid on the day of training.
3. Should the weather be unsuitable on the day, an alternative day will be arranged.
4. All booking deposits are non-refundable. However, the standard booking deposit is valid for twelve months from the date of the booking, and should you be unable to complete your jump due to inclement weather, alternative arrangements will be made. This covers various costs assisting you to carry out your jump.
5. **Tandem Parachuting** will act as your agent in arranging for your jump, and not as the agent for the Parachute Centre. We will arrange jumps only with those centres which are affiliated to the **British Parachute Association** as the National Governing Body of the sport. Accordingly, no representations or warranties of any kind are made as to the suitability, capability, and quality of training or operation of any parachute centre. Any queries or complaints with regard to these aspects should be referred to the parachute centre concerned.
6. **Sponsorship money is due 4 weeks after your jump and to be paid direct to your chosen charity or group.**

**MEDICAL RESTRICTIONS**

For an Accelerated Free Fall course you must be at least 16 years old. You will be required to sign a medical form before your jump declaring your fitness to take part. Those under 18 years of age will need the medical form signed by a parent or guardian; those aged 40 and over will need it signed by their doctor.

**Insurance**

On payment of the fee for the training and the jump, all jumpers are covered by the British Parachute Association Liability Insurance Policy for up to £2million for liability to Third Parties. **Please note that this does not cover you or your dependents for personal injury or death.** You are required to take out your own insurance to cover for personal accident benefits to whatever level you consider appropriate. You can do this either in conjunction with your own insurance broker, or you may take advantage of an alternative scheme that Tandem Parachuting can give you information on.
